Williams Unified ASSETS (After School Safety and Enrichment for Teens) The ASSETS after-school program offers a diverse set of modules. Each module caters to different interests and needs of students. Included is a brief overview of each module:

AP Courses: Advanced Placement courses offer students the opportunity to take college-level classes while still in high school. This can provide them with a head start on their college education.
